MARTIN BOYLAN PRIZE WEDNESDAY 15TH JUNE 2005

Each year the last meeting of the summer term is devoted to presentations from anaesthetists currently training in the region. Papers are now being invited for this year's competition, which as you are aware, is named in memory of the late Martin Boylan, past secretary of the Society

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone employed in a training post in anaesthesia in the area served by the Society.

CONTENT: Papers describing original research, a clinical case series or a review of a clinical topic will be considered. Original research should have been carried out substantially whilst employed as an anaesthetist within the region, and authors are required to clearly identify the contributions made by other workers.

ASSESSMENT: Papers will be judged on the basis of a ten minute oral presentation to the June meeting of the Society. They will be assessed by a small panel of judges according to content, quality of presentation and response to questions from the audience.

PRIZES: The two best papers will each be awarded a prize of £100.

APPLICATIONS: An abstract of the paper, typed, double spaced and occupying no more than a single side of A4, must be submitted no later than *Wednesday18th May 2005*. Those chosen for presentation will be notified within two weeks of that date. Applications should be addressed to:
