YORKSHIRE SOCIETY OF ANAESTHETISTS

MARTIN BOYLAN PRIZE and WEST YORKSHIRE CRITICAL CARE NETWORK PRIZE Wednesday 13th June 2007

Each year the last meeting of the summer term is devoted to presentations from anaesthetists currently training in the region. Papers are now being invited for this year's competition which is named in memory of the late Martin Boylan, past secretary of the Society. The West Yorkshire Critical Care network has joined forces with the YSA for this meting and is offering a prize for a critical care related topic.

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone employed in a training post in anaesthesia within Yorkshire.

CONTENT: The Boylan prize will be awarded for a paper describing original research, a clinical case series or a review of a clinical topic. Original research should have been carried out substantially whilst employed as an anaesthetist within the Yorkshire region, and authors are required to clearly identify the contributions made by other workers. The WYCCN prize will be awarded for the most promising Intensive Care Medicine related submission.

ASSESSMENT: Papers will be judged on the basis of a ten minute oral presentation to the June meeting of the Society. They will be assessed by a small panel of judges according to content and quality of presentation.

PRIZES: An award of £150 will be made for each prize.

APPLICATIONS: An abstract of the paper, typed, double spaced and occupying no more than a single side of A4, must be submitted no later than Friday 25th May 2007. Authors are asked to indicate which prize they wish to be considered for.
