Directions to the Village Hotel, Hull

The Village Hotel Henry Boot Way Priory Park Hull, HU4 7DY

The Village hotel is conveniently situated just off the main A63 west of Hull City Centre. Leave the A63 having passed the Humber Bridge at the next exit signposted Hessle. At the slip road lights turn left and get into the right hand lane. At the first lights go straight on and turn right at the second set of lights (the park and ride bus service is to your right). At the roundabout take the second exit. Follow the road around and at the next roundabout turn right and the Village Hotel and car park is on the right. (The hotel is well signposted after the right turn at the lights).

To Join the A63

From the West – proceed east on the M62 which becomes the A63 15 miles west of Hull.

From the North – follow signs to the Humber Bridge A15. At the large roundabout before the bridge turn right (3rd exit) and in the left lane take the 2nd ext at the next roundabout filtering onto the A63 sign posted Hull

From the South – cross the Humber Bridge A15 and turn left at the major roundabout after the toll. Sty in the left hand lane and take the 2nd exit at the next roundabout filtering onto the A63 sign posted Sancton. Proceed through South Cave towards A63 turn left onto A63 and the turn is approximately 6 miles.
